

Precept survey: PCC proposes increase in precept to fund Constabulary in 2023/24

One of the most important responsibilities of Tim Passmore, Suffolk Police and Crime Commissioner is setting the budget. Tim Passmore must ensure that Suffolk Police have the resources needed to provide an efficient and effective service.

Later this month, Tim Passmore will need to make a decision about the policing element of the council tax precept. He is planning to ask the Police and Crime Panel to support his proposal to raise the policing element of the precept by £15 a year (for a Band D property) which is essential to maintain an efficient and effective service, and provide the resources needed to manage demand as effectively as possible.
